


The reference luminous flux shall be multiplied by the correction factor in Table 5. This claim may be made only if:</p> <p>–</p> <p>the luminous intensity in any direction around the tube axis does not deviate by more than 25 % from the average luminous intensity around the tube; and</p> <p>–</p> <p>the luminous flux of the LED light source is not lower than the luminous flux of the fluorescent light source of the claimed wattage. The luminous flux of the fluorescent light source shall be obtained by multiplying the claimed wattage with the minimum luminous efficacy value corresponding to the fluorescent light source in Table 8; and</p> <p>–</p> <p>the wattage of the LED light source is not higher than the wattage of the fluorescent light source it is claimed to replace.</p> <p>The technical documentation file shall provide the data to support such claims.</p>
